KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS NOVEMBER 20, 2017

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, November 20, 2017 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. All members were present.

Berg moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Berg seconded to approve the minutes of November 13, 2017 and November 14, 2017 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding Keokuk County Highway Department. Snow plows and spreaders are being installed on trucks, temporary mower operator employees are done for the year and Engineer McGuire informed he was asked to serve on Federal Aid Swap committees.

Berg moved, Wood seconded to approve the November 20, 2017 claim listing as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

County Recorder Goldman received Board approval of part-time Clerk replacement at the time of former Clerk's resignation.

Berg moved, Wood seconded to approve the Personnel Report for Tracy Van Weelden, part-time Recorder's Clerk at \$12.00 /hour effective December 4, 2017 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended a HIPAA meeting. Berg attended an English River Watershed meeting. Hadley attended Semco and Endowment meetings and signed financial paperwork for Rural Housing Trust Fund last week.

Jim also commented on his request to set the speed patrol radar trailer in Ollie to hopefully help curb the speeding through town. Keokuk County library update was held with Keota, Richland and Sigourney librarians to update the Board on grant application/receipt, activities, projects and overall accomplishments to date.
