

PROCEEDINGS: Keokuk Co.

KEOKUK COUNTY
BOARD PROCEEDINGS
FEBRUARY 25, 2019

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, February 25, 2019 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael Berg, Michael C. Hadley and Christy Bates, County Auditor. Daryl Wood was absent.

Berg moved, Hadley seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Joint meeting with Keokuk County Conference Board was held with Drew Sanders, Assessor. Also present were City representatives - Doug Glandon, Sigourney Mayor; Grant Altenhofen, Harper Mayor; Bob Crawford, Hedrick Mayor and School representatives - Denise Conrad, Sigourney Schools and Alan Ackerman, EV Schools. County Auditor Bates served as recording secretary for both Boards. Glandon moved, Conrad seconded to approve the January 31, 2019 Conference Board minutes as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Public hearing with Keokuk County Conference Board regarding FY 2019-20 Assessor's budget was held. Assessor Sanders informed the budget was published in the official news-papers and received no oral or written objections. Auditor Bates also confirmed no receipt of oral or written objections. Hadley moved, Glandon seconded to close said public hearing. All ayes and the public hearing closed at 8:34 a.m.

Adoption of the Assessor's FY 2019-20 budget was held. Ackerman moved, Altenhofen seconded to adopt the FY 2019-20 Assessor's budget as presented. All ayes and motion carried. Sanders informed notice was received from the Dept. of Revenue stating the agricultural information will not be available until April 5, 2019 due to the recent government shutdown and reminded assessment notices are mandated to be sent prior to April 1st. An internal dwelling sheet was recently mailed to be filled out by property

owner and returned.

Hadley moved, Berg seconded to approve the minutes of February 19, 2019 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Charlie Comfort, The News-Review.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department as follows: the roads are in pretty good shape; salt is currently coming in regular loads; maintainer issues are under warranty and equipment is being repaired. The final pavement design was received from French-Reneker for the Belva Deer trail project and crews are cutting brush.

Hadley moved, Berg seconded approval of Tomisha L. Hammes' Certificate of Appointment as Commissioner to Area XV Multi-County Housing Agency as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Berg attended an Empowerment meeting, while the Decat meeting was cancelled due to lack of a quorum. Hadley attended E911, Endowment and Semco meetings last week. Charlie Comfort exited at 9:15 a.m.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Area XV sent their quarterly report for review. Iowa Economic Development sent a flyer regarding Community Catalyst Building Remediation Program to share. Hadley shared the custodian job description updated by Mike Galloway, Ahlers & Cooney, for review. Bates distributed a full copy of the Keokuk County budget for fiscal year 2020, publish page to be placed in February 27th official newspapers.

Hadley moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:45 a.m.
